Using the EWGA Golf Life Management System (GLMS) – More on Peer Review

The essential elements of obtaining a valid Handicap Index are:

- belong to a club that is licensed to provide handicapping services to its members
- play your best on each hole
- [post all acceptable scores](#) promptly after you play
- peer review

The EWGA GLMS provides the opportunity to review scores of your fellow Chapter members. You can keep a list of players with whom you play frequently in your Main Player List or you can see a list of everyone in the Chapter and their Handicap Index and scoring record on the Member Roster list.

Main Player List

To set up your own personal player list to monitor scoring and handicap indexes:

- login to the GLMS
- On your Home Page, go to My Lists in the bottom right hand portion of the screen
- On the My Lists page, select Main Player List
- Click on Add
- Enter the Name and state of the player you want to add to your player list and click Search
- Select a player from the search results list and the player will be added to your Player List
- Add as many players as you like or delete them at any time
- This list of players will appear on the bottom right of your Home Page so you can easily see their handicap index and their scoring record when you login to the GLMS system

Member Roster

At any time, you can login to the GLMS and see a list of all the Palm Beach County Chapter members who are keeping their handicap index on the EWGA GLMS system.

- Login to the GLMS
- From your Home Page, select My Home Club – a red button in the middle of the page
- From the Club Profile page, select Member Roster – a red button on the right hand side of the page
- A member roster list will appear
- You can sort this in a variety of ways including alphabetically, my handicap index, etc by selecting a choice from the pull down Sort By List
- Click on any member's Handicap Index to see their full scoring record
- To see the scores used for their handicap index calculation click on the Handicap Scores button
- NOTE: On the roster list, you may see players whose membership in the Chapter has expired but their scoring record while they were members can still be viewed. **Only members with a Membership Renewal Date in the future are current active Chapter members and are able to login to the GLMS to post scores and have a verifiable Handicap Index.**
