

Using the EWGA Golf Life Management System – My Player Profile

The EWGA Golf Life Management System (GLMS), available to all EWGA Chapter members, is more than just a way to Post Scores and Track Your Handicap Index[®]. You can also share information about your “golf life” with other EWGA members or learn about the “golf life” of your fellow members! *Here’s how to begin:*

Update Your Player Profile

From your GLMS **My Home Page**, click on the red **My Player Profile** button under the My Golf Life button list in the middle of the screen. On the My Player Profile screen, you will see information about yourself that comes from the main EWGA membership database:

- Chapter Affiliation
- Member ID
- Home Address
- Home Phone
- Work Phone
- Email address

This information is automatically updated in the GLMS whenever you update your Member Record in the EWGA Members Only area of the EWGA website (www.ewga.com). *NOTE: A quick way to access your membership database information from inside the EWGA GLMS is to click on the “Player Profile Edit” in the blue side menu on the left hand side of the screen. This will take you to the screen where you can update your address, phone, and email.*

From within the EWGA GLMS, however, you can add and update other interesting information about your “golf life” for fellow EWGA members. Just click on the **Update Photo and Text** button on the right hand side of the player profile screen. In this section you can enter:

- Your personal greeting or statement about golf
- A description of yourself, your family, your work, your dogs, etc.
- Your Greatest Golf Moment
- Achievement in Golf
- Record any Hole-in-Ones you have had
- Update a picture of yourself (needs to be formatted as .jpg or .gif 1 inch x 1 inch)
- Click the **SUBMIT** button at the bottom to update your profile

Once you update this area, your entries will appear on your Player Profile page and your fellow members can learn more about you and your “golf life”.

Look Up Other Players

To see the Player Profile and Scoring Record of other players using the GLMS, click on the **PLAYERS** button on the blue top menu bar of the EWGA GLMS screen. Enter the Player’s first and last name and state and see if their name appears on the Search Results list. (You can look up information on an EWGA member from any EWGA Chapter.) If they are on the list, just click on their name to see their Player Profile and learn more about their “golf life”.

NOTE: Do not be surprised if you look up a name and see members from other golf clubs. The EWGA has a version of the GLMS designed just for our Association but the GLMS is also used by many other golf clubs and golf associations to track player and scoring information.
